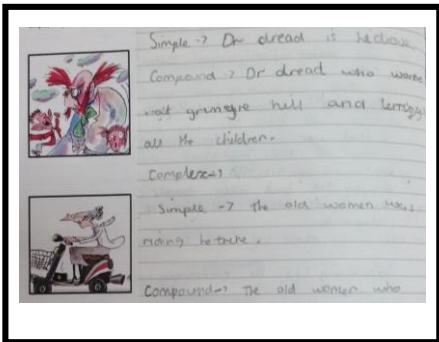
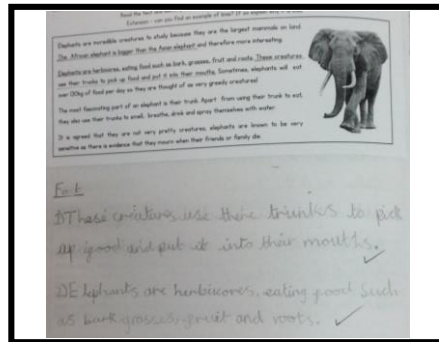


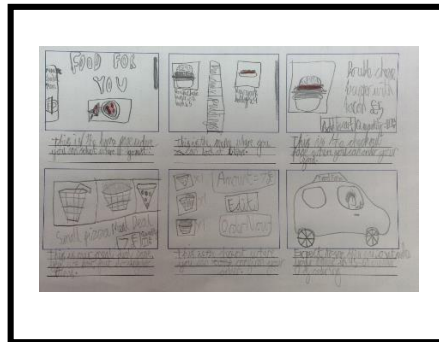
Week 1
 In Art children utilised skills to create their own 'World's Worst Teacher.' They had a variety of features they had to roll a die to choose. They then put the features together to create their character.



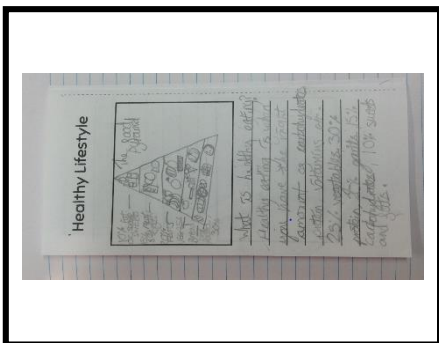
Week 2

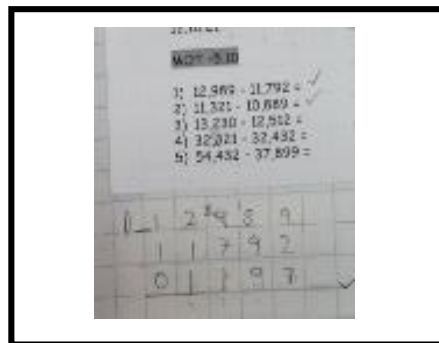
Week 4
